WHAT

At the moment, as a new and young organisation, we have about 170 individual members, made up of volunteers, supporters, staff and friends, people from the Churches which have been involved with the project, plus magistrates, experts in citizen's advice and women's refuge affairs, councillors, peers, vicars and priests. 17 Churches, businesses and schools are registered as corporate members.
