Most people know DENS as the homeless charity for people in Dacorum. In fact, DENS does so much more than just provide a roof and a bed. Our aim is to be the first port of call for people in Dacorum who are facing homelessness, poverty and social exclusion; to support and empower them to take the next positive step in their lives.

About Employment & Skills:

Our Employment & Skills team offer a range of opportunities to help people build skills for life and work. We run awesome projects to help raise vital funds for the charity, and we use Vinted and other platforms to sell donated and handmade items.

About the opportunity:

We're looking for a friendly and reliable volunteer to help run our Vinted account, helping to generate vital funds to support the charity's services. You will also run our 'Vinted club' supervising small groups of hostel residents to help out whilst learning new skills. We are flexible on what day(s) of the week you would like to work.

Full training will be provided, including an induction into life at DENS, and tutorials in using the platforms and following our processes, plus training in safeguarding and professional boundaries. You will have a dedicated point of contact to support you with any issues that may arise, and we'll also cover your expenses like travel costs.

What you will be doing:

- Sorting donated items (clothes, shoes, accessories)
- Researching items and their sale value
- Washing/steaming clothes
- Taking clear, appealing photographs of items
- Creating accurate and engaging listings to maximise sales
- Packing and dispatching sold items promptly and securely
- Monitoring accounts and responding to customer queries
- Organising stock
- Supervising small groups of residents to do tasks involved in selling on Vinted
- Work collaboratively with staff and other volunteers
- Follow charity policies and procedures
- Booking and overseeing cash4clothes collections

- Practical skills in organisation, teamwork, and logistics
